

STATE'S ATTORNEY AISHA BRAVEBOY TO HOLD PRESS CONFERENCE AFTER SENTENCING OF MAN CONVICTED OF KILLING APPLEBEE'S EMPLOYEE

UPPER MARLBORO, MD – A 24-year-old Suitland man is scheduled to be sentenced tomorrow on first-degree murder and related charges. State's Attorney Braveboy will hold a news conference following the hearing.

David Isaiah Yates shot and killed Anthony Evans, an employee at the Applebee's Grill and Bar on Donnell Drive in Forestville in May of 2021. The tragedy stemmed from a fight between employees and a group of customers over the closing time. As they were gathering outside before heading home, a car driven by Keith Cook, in which Yates was the passenger pulled up. Yates fired over the top of the vehicle, striking Evans, 38 and two others, who survived. Yates was found guilty on Friday, August 4th.
