## HYATTSVILLE MAN SENTENCED TO 30 YEARS FOR SEXUALLY ABUSING HIS DAUGHTER AND OTHER CHILDREN

UPPER MARLBORO, MD – Jaimen Sical, 48, was sentenced on Thursday to 85 years with all but 30 years suspended.

Sical was convicted of sexually abusing his daughter and her twin half-sisters. During court testimony, it was revealed that Sical would abuse the girls at his home while babysitting them. At the time of the abuse, the twin girls were between 8 and 10 years old, and his daughter was just 7 years old.

“These young, precious victims were abused and traumatized by Mr. Sical,” said State’s Attorney Aisha Braveboy. “It’s truly heartbreaking to think what they have gone through because of his disgusting actions. I am pleased with the sentence against him that ensures Mr. Sical won’t be able to harm them again. I also want to thank Assistant State’s Attorney Ashley Elias for her hard work on this case, and dedication to the Special Victims and Family Violence Unit.”

This case was referred to the Hyattsville Police Department in 2019 from Montgomery County. One of the victims had a panic attack after learning about “good touches” and “bad touches” at school, leading to her disclosing the abuse. She was 12 years old at the time of the disclosure.

After a four-day trial, Sical was found guilty on March 30, 2023. He was convicted on two counts of sexual abuse of a minor, one count of sexual abuse of a minor, and one count of third-degree sex offense.

As part of his sentence he is required have to register for life as a sex offender, submit to a sex offender monitoring program and be on 5 years of supervised probation upon release. The judge also ordered that he have no contact with the victims.
